Our classes at the Eastern Shore Art Center are for EVERYONE!! We love to have beginners as well as accomplished artists, so come try a new medium or fine tune your technique. There is something for everyone.

Register in person, by credit card over the telephone at 251-928-2228 or online at our website: www.esartcenter.com. The ESAC accepts cash, checks, VISA and MasterCard. Full tuition payment must accompany registration. Please register early. Classes which don't meet the minimum requirement of five students by the registration deadline will be cancelled.

SPRING REGISTRATION DEADLINE IS WEDNESDAY, June 2, 2010 at 5:00 p.m.

REFUNDS

The Eastern Shore Art Center will fully refund tuition if a student withdraws from a class by June, 2, 2010. If a class doesn't meet the minimum enrollment, students may receive a full refund or transfer their tuition to another class. For workshops, ESAC will fully refund the tuition if a student withdraws 30 days prior to the first day of the workshop. If a student withdraws after the deadline for a class or workshop, the tuition cost will be considered a charitable contribution to the Eastern Shore Art Center.

Frequently Asked Questions about the Academy and Art Classes at ESAC

- When do the new quarters start? We have 4 quarters each year: Winter, Spring, Summer and Fall. They typically begin the second or third week of January, March, June and September. Watch the website for the announcements of each new schedule.
- Are there supplies that I need to bring to the art classes? For our adult classes, there are supply lists for each class. We can email you one or you can pick it up at the Art Center. Just ask for one when you register. For our children's classes, all supplies are furnished unless otherwise noted.
- Can I register online if I don't have a PayPal account? Yes you can! Just select your class or classes and when you get to the PayPal log in page, select the no PayPal account option. You will be directed to enter a credit card number and then you're done. Use this method even if you have a PayPal account but choose to pay by a credit card.
- What level of membership do I need to be to get the class discount? To get the class discount you need to be a Supporting Level Member or above. The Supporting Level is \$100 and includes you and your immediate family for 12 months from the day you join or renew.

Beginners will have projects that will teach how to mix color, how to arrange color on the palette and how to choose proper subjects. More advanced students will be given projects that are more challenging. Each project will teach a specific practice that will make you a better painter as you develop your own style. You'll need a willingness to do various exercises to accomplish that goal. An ability to draw will make this class more enjoyable. The class will cover composition, color theory, and among other things, how to make a picture into a work of art. Ask for a supply list when you register.
