- The cost of each class during Sessions 1, 2 & 3 is **\$100** for supporting level members and above/all others: **\$120**. The cost for each class during Session 4 (1 week session) is **\$50** for supporting level members and above/all others: **\$70**. Full tuition is due at the time of registration.
- **New this year, multi child discount!** Two or more children in the same family registered in the **same** session, you will receive 10% off each child's class.
- ESAC will fully refund tuition if a student withdraws 5 DAYS PRIOR to the first class. If a class does not meet minimum enrollment, students may choose to receive a full refund or transfer to another class, space available.
- If you choose a morning and afternoon class for your child, there is a supervised lunch period (send a lunch) for a charge of \$20 for the two week sessions and \$10 for the one week session.
- There will be an art show during the last day of each session to display your child's artwork. All studios will be open with artwork on display the last 30 minutes of class. Students and parents are encouraged to visit all studios and discuss art forms on display.
- Art can be a very messy situation, that's what makes it fun! Please dress your child for getting messy.
- It is essential to be punctual when dropping off and picking up your child. Our teachers are working diligently to have each day be the best it can be for your child and they need all their prep time. We appreciate your cooperation in this matter. For your child's safety, please come in to the studios to pick up your child each day.
- There is a snack time during each class period, please send a snack with your child. There is a snack machine located in the Academy for your convenience. Sodas are \$.75 and the snacks range from \$.75-\$1.00. We do request that you assist your child in purchasing snacks prior to class.
- Your child must be 3 years old by March 1, 2010 and out of diapers to participate in the 3 to 5 year old classes.
- Your child must have completed First Grade to participate in the Pottery classes.
